One difference between Lutheranism and Calvinism relates to the two natures of Christ.

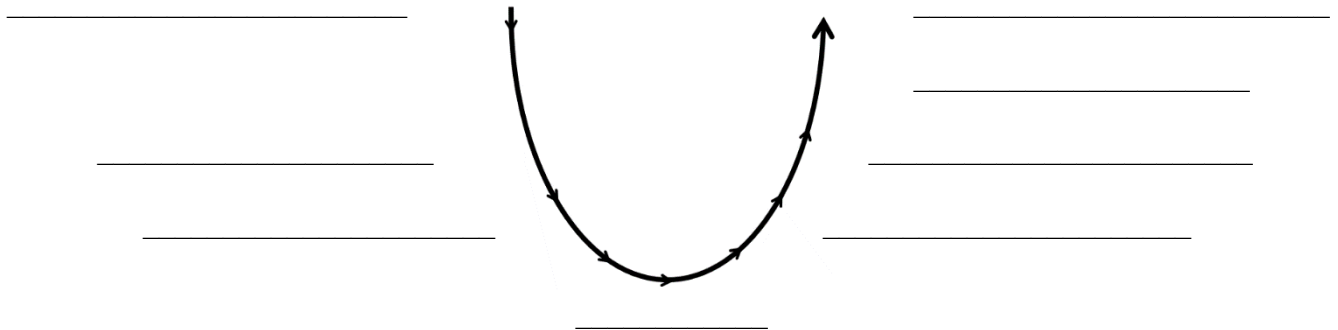

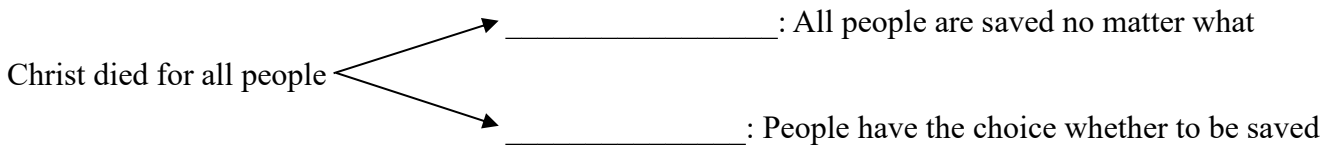
