A. From the Holy Spirit, who works it in our hearts by the preaching of the gospel, and strengthens it by the use of the sacraments.

Q. How does God make Himself known to us?

A. By two means.

Firstly by general revelation,

which is His works of creation and providence telling all people of His greatness and goodness. Secondly by special revelation,

which is His Word directed to specific people.

Q. Is general revelation sufficient to know God?

A. Yes.

However, fallen, sinful man is incapable of understanding it. Thus it is no longer sufficient to teach people about God.
