81. Q. Who are to come to the table of the Lord?

A. *Those who are truly unhappy with themselves
because of their sins
and yet trust that their sins are forgiven,
and desire to be better believers and do more good in life.
But hypocrites and those who do not repent
eat and drink judgment upon themselves.*

82. Q. Are those also to be admitted to the Lord's Supper who by their confession and life show that they are unbelieving and ungodly?

A. *No, for then the covenant of God would be profaned
and His wrath kindled against the whole congregation.
Therefore,
according to the command of Christ and His apostles,
the Christian church is duty-bound to exclude such persons
by the keys of the kingdom of heaven, until they amend their lives.*
