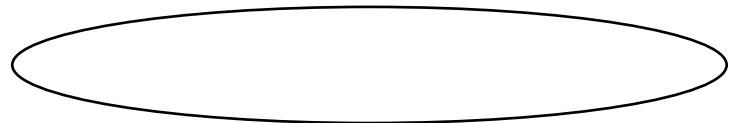
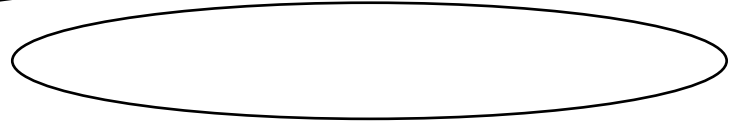
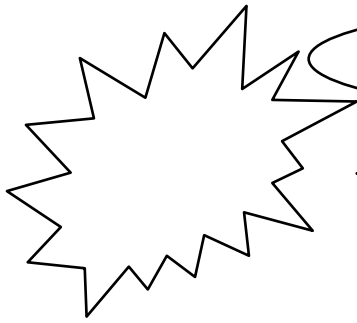
### ***A debated issue***

The Roman Catholic church believes the keys were given to the person of Peter. They are now in the hands of the Pope. He can personally ban people from God's Kingdom.

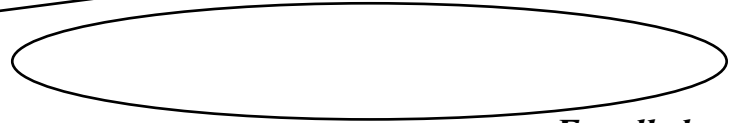
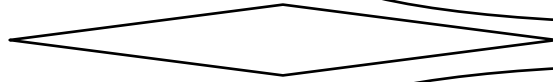
