Memory work

than He has commanded in His Word.*

97. Q. May we then not make any image at all?

A. *God cannot and may not be visibly portrayed in any way.
Creatures may be portrayed,
but God forbids us to make or have any images of them
in order to worship them
or to serve God through them.*

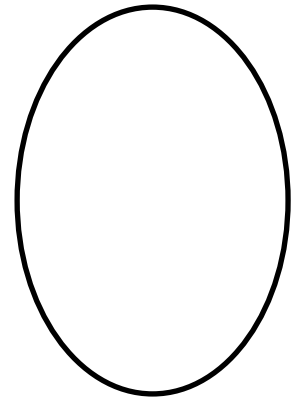
