Memory work (*q&a 124 OR Hymn 63:4*)

124.Q. What is the third petition?

A. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

That is:

*Grant that we and all men may deny our own will,
and without any murmuring obey Your will,
for it alone is good.*

*Grant also that everyone
may carry out the duties of his office and calling
as willingly and faithfully as the angels in heaven.*

*O Father, may your will be done
on earth below by everyone.*

*May we deny our wilful way,
and, without murm'ring, you obey.*

*In all our duties, Lord, may we,
like heaven's angels, faithful be.*
